

Clark County State Fair Point Scale

- 20 points Weighted State Fair Evaluation. 65% of the score comes from the adult chaperones. 35% will come from the average peer evaluation score. An evaluation grid will outline expectations. As an example: An average score would be 15 pts. Superior leadership and work habits 20pts. Poor participation 10 pts. Not working effectively with others, not showing up for barn duty, etc. would garner 5 pts.
- 10 points Exhibit dairy cattle at the previous Clark County Fair
- 5 points Clark County 4-H Dairy Judging Team
- 5 points County Fitting & Showing Workshops
- 5 points Participate in a contest at Area Animal Science Days ie Dairy Poster, Bovology, Showmanship, dairy judging
- 5 points Clark County Dairy Bowl Team
- 5 points Participate in a club or county 4-H Dairy Project Meeting or event
- 5 point Post secondary involvement in dairying ie dairy club, dairy judging, college dairy sale, farm labor/employment
- 1 point Jr. Holstein or FFA Dairy Quiz Bowl Team
- 1 point for each Breed show exhibited ie District, Parish or Canton shows; Other county fairs or local shows ie Marshfield, Athens, Chippewa; State breed shows; World Dairy Expo
- 1 point FFA or Jr. Holstein Dairy Judging ie River Falls Tech days, State FFA Contest in Madison, FFA judging at World Dairy Expo, WI Championship Show Judging Contest
- 1 point Breed Convention ie WI Holstein Convention, WI Jersey Convention

The State Fair Points will be accumulated annually beginning on June 1 of the previous year. This allows 12 months for dairy youth to accumulate State Fair Points before State Fair tryouts and would include the State Fair Evaluation from the previous year.
