

**Swine Committee Meeting  
February 6, 2018  
ADS – Greenwood**

The swine committee meeting was called to order at 7:40 p.m. by Grant Koski.

Members present were: Grant Koski, Ed Hamel, Mark Becker, Harlan Hinkelmann, Terry Byrne, Carla Byrne, Todd Cerven, John Gutowski, Adam Luchterhand, and Wayne Artac.

Grant had talked to a state vet about our options with the new laws regarding PRRS and SECD that took effect February 1, 2018.

A motion was made by Harlan and seconded by Ed to have no initial weigh in and be a terminal show for 2018. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Adam and seconded by Harlan stating that on April 14 swine exhibitors will come to county garage between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. to pick up tags and ID forms and Rules/Regulations signature page. Exhibitors need not be present. After picking up tags swine must be tagged and notched. Then a photo must be taken with tag number and ear notches – both ears must be visible. The photo and ID forms and a copy of the Certified Veterinary Inspection (CVI) will be due back to the UW-Extension Office by April 23 (or postmarked). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their own tagger. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Harlan and seconded by John that because this is a terminal show swine must go to a committee approved slaughter facility / slaughter sale. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ed and seconded by Mark to hold an informational meeting to discuss these new rules being installed for this year's fair. This meeting attendance is highly recommended for parents as well as leaders and FFA advisors. This does not count as an educational point. Motion carried. Tentative date for meeting will be March 19, 7:30 p.m. with location to be determined.

Motion to adjourn made by Harlan, seconded by Ed. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
