4. Reviewed the Swine Agreement form and ID picture form. The line NO RETAKES WILL BE ALLOWED was added to the ID picture form. If there is a question about a picture, contact Grant Koski. The pictures must be clear with the ear notches VISIBLE and tag number showing in one picture only.
5. Tag pick up will be held at Loyal Highway Garage on April 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Youth do not need to be present at pick up. If families are picking up for other families that information must be conveyed to Lori and she will create registration check in list.
6. The signed Swine Agreement form, ID picture form, and copy of PRRS/SECD test results MUST be postmarked by April 22 to the Extension Office.
7. John Gutowski, Ed Hamel, Harlan Hinkelmann, Adam Luchterhand, Sheri Jacque, Eric Statz, Grant Koski, and Mark Becker will review swine pictures the week of May 1st
