- ** Scholarship recipients are required to work at least one shift in the 4-H Food Stand at the Clark County Fair the summer following their trip.
- ** Scholarship recipients are expected to give a presentation to their own club or another club about their trip.
- ** Interviews are required and will be scheduled after the application due date.
