- 3. 4-H and FFA crossover animals must be pre-registered by the Open Class deadline to participate.
- 4. Breed registered ancestry standards:

Holsteins 87% All other breeds 75%

- 5. Animals shown in Dry Cow classes must be coded dry on production test sheets or at least 280 days on IBM test sheet.
- 6. Exhibitors must bring their own feed and bedding.
- 7. Milking parlor will not be open until Thursday afternoon.
- 8. The parlor will be open at all times except from 2:00—3:00 p.m. and 8:00 –9:00 p.m. for washing and during the 15—20 minutes when the bulk tank is emptied and cleaned.
- 9. No automatic waterers connected to faucets allowed.
- 10. Class G—Red & White—must be registered with the RWDCA, Red & White Dairy Cattle Association.
- 11. Cattle must be in place by Friday evening.
