





## Regulations / Requirements – Open Class Beef

1. Open to residents of Wisconsin.
2. All animals must be purebred. Registration papers must be furnished upon request.
3. 4-H and FFA crossover animals must be pre-registered by the Open Class deadline to participate.
4. **Breed registered ancestry standards:**

Holsteins	87%
All other breeds	75%
5. Animals shown in Dry Cow classes must be coded dry on production test sheets or at least 280 days on IBM test sheet.
6. Exhibitors must bring their own feed and bedding.
7. Milking parlor will not be open until Thursday afternoon.
8. The parlor will be open at all times except from 2:00—3:00 p.m. and 8:00 –9:00 p.m. for washing and during the 15—20 minutes when the bulk tank is emptied and cleaned.
9. No automatic waterers connected to faucets allowed.
10. Class G—Red & White—must be registered with the RWDCA, Red & White Dairy Cattle Association.
11. Cattle must be in place by Friday evening.
