## **Rabbit Requirements:**

1. Limit of **12** rabbits per exhibitor.
2. This is a non-cooped show.
3. All entries must arrive and be in place by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday (week of fair).
4. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own rabbits and should check on their rabbits throughout the event.
5. Open Class rabbits are not eligible for Market Sale.
6. All rabbits must be tattooed before Tuesday (week of fair).
7. Exhibitors must be present for judging and exhibitor entry number must be worn when showing rabbits.
8. All age and weight specifications are those used by the American Rabbit Breeders Association and these will be adhered to.
9. Rabbits will not be allowed to enter if they are pregnant or with a litter.
10. Rabbits that are uncontrollable when being handled, not accustomed to being cages, or not tame, will not be admitted for exhibition.
11. Placings will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th
