- 2. This is a non-cooped show.
- 3. All entries must arrive and be in place by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday (week of fair).
- 4. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own rabbits and should check on their rabbits throughout the event.
- 5. Open Class rabbits are not eligible for Market Sale.
- 6. All rabbits must be tattooed before Tuesday (week of fair).
- 7. Exhibitors must be present for judging and exhibitor entry number must be worn when showing rabbits.
- 8. All age and weight specifications are those used by the American Rabbit Breeders Association and these will be adhered to.
- 9. Rabbits will not be allowed to enter if they are pregnant or with a litter.
- 10. Rabbits that are uncontrollable when being handled, not accustomed to being cages, or not tame, will not be admitted for exhibition.
