Old Business:

☐ Fair – Three suggestion boxes were placed in various buildings during the fair. Changes/ideas were also discussed at meeting. Someone new will need to take over the project check in as the person currently in charge is stepping down. Lori reported there were 2000 “no show” projects: 1500 from 4-H and 500 from other clubs/organizations.

☐ Record books – Club leaders select record books nominated to move to county level for awards. Oct 10th at 4:00 will be the county record book review; this is open to any leader that's able to attend.

New Business:

☐ Space Camp increase – We have one applicant. There was a price increase of the trip from the time of registration to now; from \$1650 to \$2000. A motion was made by Lori and seconded by John to cover an additional \$175 of the trip cost.

☐ Scholarship Revamp – Teri and Nikki will work on the forms. It was discussed to add that scholarship winners will be required to work in the food stand. Changes will also be made to the record book requirement.

☐ Awards Banquet – Date is pending as Seth is waiting confirmation from Greenwood School. This will be potluck.

☐ Leader's Fed Board – a brief discussion was held about members who's terms are up. Also; how to encourage youth and adults to be on the board?

☐ End of Year Report - Lori has the financial part done. The Goals & Missions part is done by Leader's Fed.

☐ Fair book review meetings – Leader's Federation will be taking suggestions to make changes to fair book and will be taking those to the Fair Board.

☐ Fall Forum – Nov 4-6 in WI Rapids at Hotel Mead. Estimated cost per person is \$200. Anyone (youth or adult) that wants to attend will pay their cost up front. A motion was made to reimburse \$75 per youth **after** they have presented a club or county level presentation about Fall Forum. \$75 per adult will also will be reimbursed.
