

## **Clark County Leader's Federation Meeting Minutes March 14<sup>th</sup>, 7 pm, Greenwood ADS**

Meeting was called to order by President Teri Raatz at 7:15 pm.

Pledges were done.

Secretary's Report was approved as presented.

Treasurer's report was also approved as presented to members via email because Lori Hendrickson was unable to attend.

### **Old Business:**

- Drama/Music Fest – Everything went well even with the morning being very icy. Microphones this year worked very well, and everyone could hear the performances well.
- Snowtubing – The original date did not happen because the contract for renting the hill went to County Clerk's junk mail folder. The County Clerk has stated we were on her calendar so that is why no one called to confirm. The county did offer to rent the hill to us at a rate of \$4 person, but the second date had to be cancelled due to icy and rain. (Since the meeting date Taylor County has emailed and offered us hill rental for next year at the \$4/ person rate again).

### **New Business:**

- Ownership of the 4-H Food Stand at the Fairgrounds – It is believed that even though the Leader's Fed raised the money to build the stand because it is on county property technically the county owns the building. We do pay the Fair Board to operate the stand at the fair and we also pay an insurance fee but the insurance is just for having the food stand not for the actual building.
- Camp Discussion – Discussion was had about how much the Leader's Fed pay towards camp. It was pointed out that in the past a large portion of camp was covered by a private donation towards camp. Leader's Fed will likely be asked to pay for the rental of Kamp Kenwood. There was talk about renting a bus to get kids to camp but it was pointed out that in the past parents were responsible for getting their kids to the camp location. So, no bus will be arranged for this year's camp. Next years, 2023, camp dates will be looked at closely and camp will likely be at a later day instead of right after school is out. We are still looking for a Camp Head Cook, Youth Counselors, and Adult Leaders.
- 4-H Volleyball is scheduled for April 2-3 in Neillsville. We are in need of referees. Members going on the American Spirit Trip and Space Camp will run the concession stand for the tournament.
- Discovery Day – Will be held in Loyal on Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> from 9am-noon. Workshop topics have been set. There will be a schedule and sign up in April's newsletter. We are in need of 4-H youth to help with each session. There is no charge for 4-H members to attend, non-4-H members are \$5.
- Scholarship committee will consist of Liz, Nikki, and John. They will set a time to review the applications.

Nikki, Teri, and Liz will be getting together in a few weeks to review the trip scholarship forms.

Nikki moved to adjourn, seconded by Ella. Motion passed; meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
