

Green Thumb Challenge 2023

Rules and Guidelines

1. Open to all Clark County 4-H clubs.
2. The planter container should be a large animal mineral bin/barrel.
Common colors are black and blue.
Drill holes in the bottom for proper drainage.
3. Put your club name somewhere on the planter in a visible location.
4. Plants should be started and maintained through growing season.
5. Please identify the plants you have placed in your planter.
6. Plants should be seasonal and grown in the planter.
7. Planters should be in place by 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
8. Identify individuals who participated in creating the planter.
9. Planter locations will be drawn at the July All Leaders meeting. Planter locations will be sent to your club's designated contact person via email.

All participating 4-H clubs will receive \$25 for their planter courtesy of the Clark County 4-H Leaders Federation.
