The camp will host between 60-80 youth campers and can feed up to a total of 100 people. Applicants should have experience cooking for large groups such as church groups, schools, camps, or restaurants. The camp cook will oversee meal clean-up, with campers responsible for cleaning up after each meal. Overnight stay is not required for this position.

Qualifications:

• ServSafe certification (4-H Educators can assist with this process)

Compensation:

• \$500 stipend

Responsibilities:

- Prepare and serve 4 breakfasts
- Prepare and serve 3 lunches
- Prepare and serve 4 dinners
- Collaborate with Extension Educators to create a menu
- Educators will assist with grocery shopping

Sample Menu:

Breakfast:

• Egg bake, French toast, pancakes, scrambled eggs, dry cereal, fruit, yogurt, hash browns, sausage, etc.

Lunch:

• Loaded potatoes/French fries, mac & cheese, sun butter and jelly (alternative option), makeyour-own sandwiches, fruit plates, simple plates, tacos, hot dogs, burgers, etc.

Dinner:

 Mac & cheese, tater tot casserole, burgers, hot dogs, chicken/taters/carrot sheet pan dinner, tacos, etc.

Desserts:

• Cookies, brownies, various cakes, zucchini bread, monkey bread, banana bread, etc.
