The Secretary minutes from January 7, 2025 meeting were read and placed on file. The Treasurer's report was read.

Director Reports:

<u>Vice President for Family and Community Outreach</u>: Smart phone lesson program has been scheduled for Monday, February 17, 2025 at 11:00am.

Dairy Bar: The Dairy Bar sign will be refreshed before next year's fair.
